

Decorate a butterfly

Birth to five Matters: Positive Relationships: Parents are their children's lifelong promoters of development and learning.

You are your child's teacher:

Use descriptive language: talk about what your child is doing avoid asking questions.

Let your child be as creative as possible age appropriate.

Be warm, supportive, and encouraging.



You will need:

- Paper
- Paint brushes
- Different coloured paint
- For younger children/ babies you could use crushed fruit as paint which as long as they are on their weaning journey these would be taste safe for your curious babies .

Fold your paper in half and cut out a butterfly shape for your child to decorate, using paint or fruit paint on one side of the butterfly. Then fold to get the same pattern onto the other side of the butterfly, let your child be as creative as they want while creating their masterpiece.
