You are your child's teacher:

Talk about what your child is doing helps their language to develop by learning new words.

Set simple goals your child can achieve.

Be repetitive with the songs.

Be warm, supportive, and encouraging.

1. Place paint into the ice cube trays. You can make rainbow sticks by carefully layering the colours of the paint.
2. Freeze the paint
3. Spread out a large sheet of paper (outdoors is recommended)
4. Take out a paint stick and start painting! If the paint takes a while to melt, dip it in a cup of water.
5. As the paint begins to melt, the activity becomes more of a finger painting activity and is great fun messy play activity.
