Local services follow a step-by-step approach to assessment of SEND called the graduated response. Education, health and care professionals can help meet a child or young person's needs in their particular area. School SENCOs and GPs often help parents and carers to make referrals to these specialist services when needed. However, in line with the SEND code of practice they will also work together to get the right multi-agency support in place for children and their families.

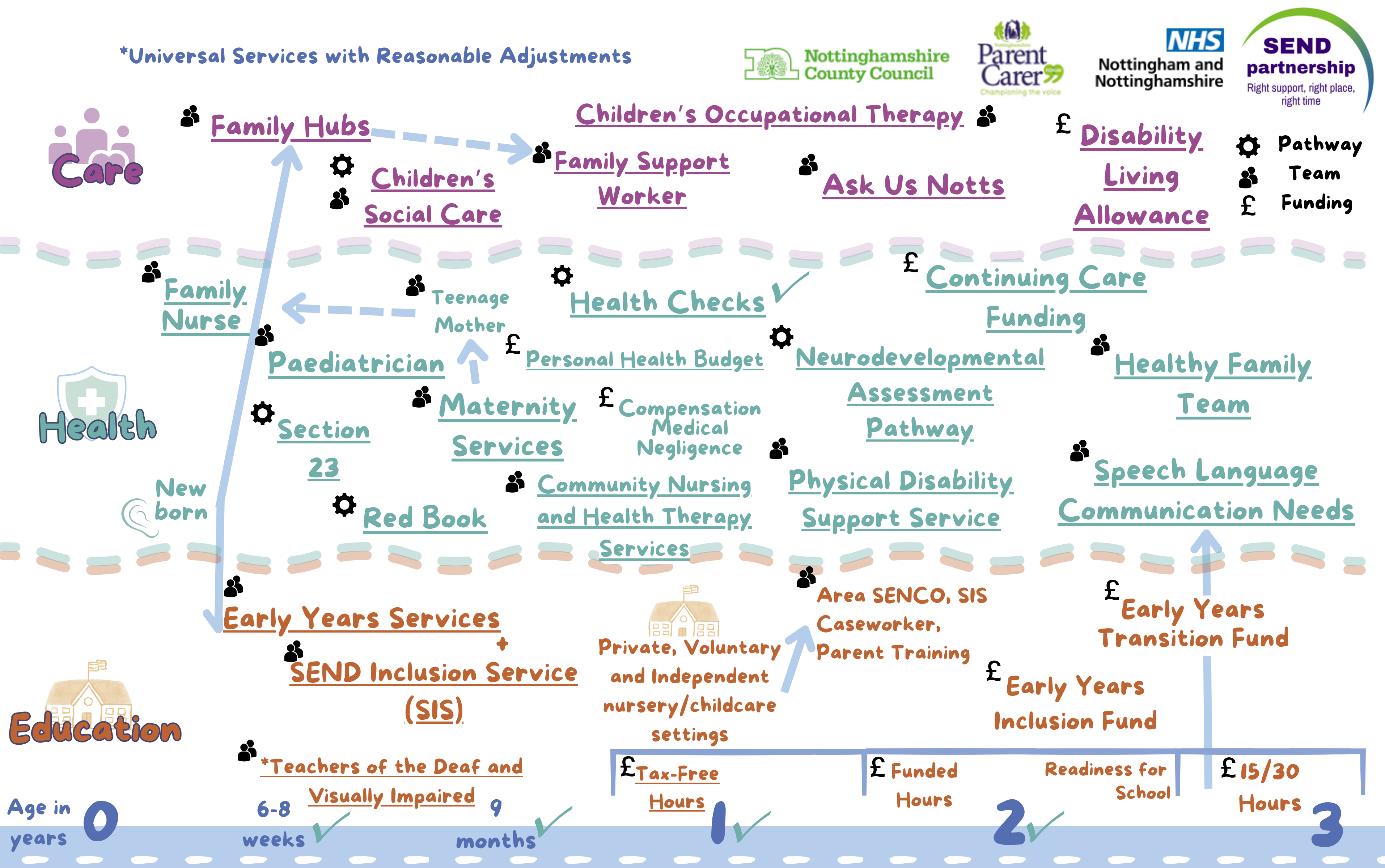

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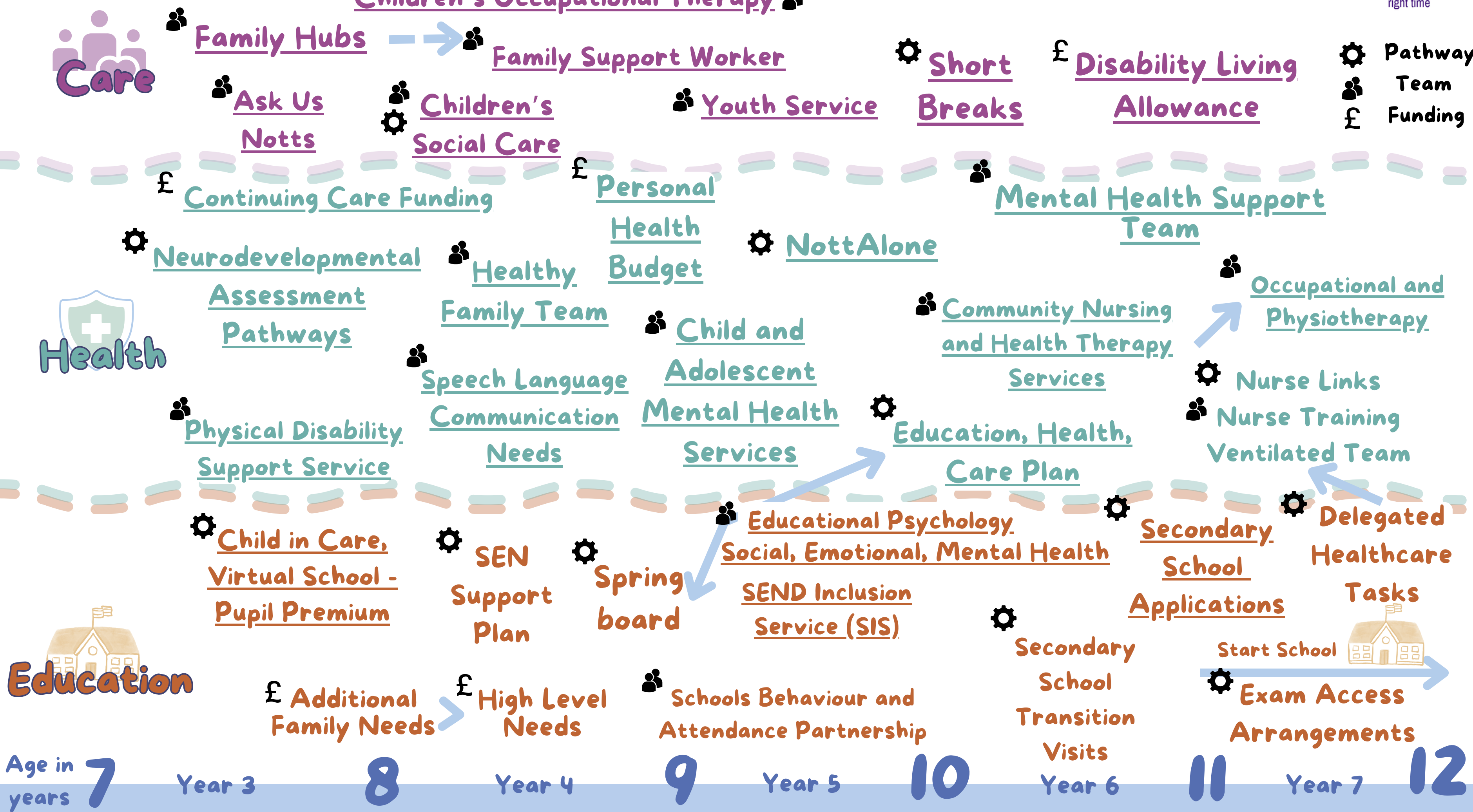

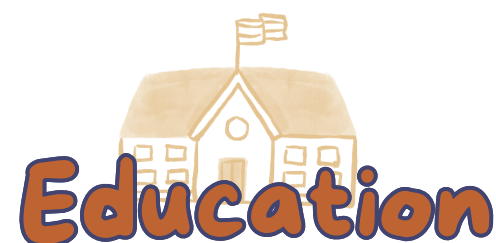
