2. Eating latkes, jelly donuts and other fried foods
3. Playing dreidel

Make a Star of David

You will need:

- 6 lollipop sticks
- Blue paint
- Glue and string

Make two triangles by gluing the lollipop stick, once dried paint them blue. Glue one on top of the other as in the picture above. Add string or ribbon and hang your star up.

You could dye some rice blue and use white rice to create a sensory activity.
