Birth to five: Personal, social and emotional development: Enabling relationship: Create opportunities to sing to and with babies and young children.

You are your child's teacher:

Use descriptive language: talk about what your child is doing avoid asking questions.

Sings song and join in with the band.

Let your child be as creative as possible.

Be warm, supportive, and encouraging.



You could create your own band by using old pots, pans, and spoons. Providing the opportunity to make different sounds,

Provide different utensils to create different sounds for example a wooden spoon or a whisk.

You could make up your own silly song or rhyme and encourage your baby or child to join in, you could use your whole body for example stomping around to the Grand old Duke of York.

Introduce metal pan lids to use as symbols, play some songs or nursery rhymes to play and sing along to.
