

Outdoor Paper plates and nature walks

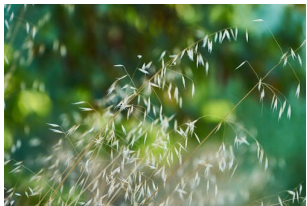

- String or ribbon

You could go on a nature walk and collect natural things from your walk to decorate your plate, once you have decorated your plate you could add ribbon or string to hang your spring wreath up.

- You could make or take some binoculars and look for birds.
