

Provision for all children with Special Educational Needs and Disability (SEND)

How will you keep my child safe and cared for?

- ◇ Regular communication between provision, parents and external agencies regarding child.
- ◇ Clear and identified strategies in place to support transitions during the day, to new rooms, other provisions and future school.
- ◇ Sign posting of parents to local and national voluntary and independent community groups through the Nottingham City SEND Local Offer.

What activities, adult interactions and support will be provided to help my child learn?

- ◇ Special Educational Needs Coordinator (SENCO) is responsible for monitoring, advising and co coordinating all specialist interventions in the setting (additional to and different from usual practice).
- ◇ Targeted advice, support, interventions provided from specialist service areas.
- ◇ **All** practitioners adopt strategies identified by SENCO / specialist services to support individual needs of the child.
- ◇ Significant differentiation of the curriculum according to child's individual needs.
- ◇ Good deployment of adults to support children with SEND.
- ◇ Targeted support for individual / group activities taking place indoors and outdoors
- ◇ All staff across the setting are aware of the individual needs and strategies to implement.

How will I / you know my child is making progress

- ◇ A SEND review meeting involving all supporting the child is held every 4 months / termly to review the child's progress and set new appropriate targets.
- ◇ Consideration is given to decide whether a Common Assessment Framework (CAF) / Team Around a Child (TAC) needs to be initiated to further support the child or the family or access to targeted services.
- ◇ Further assessment of children's strength and difficulties with advice/ support from specialists.
- ◇ Regular reviews of progress to include children, parents, carers, specialist support services and outside agencies where appropriate.
- ◇ Early Years Team (Local Authority) to be informed of all children with SEND provision.
