

## Sensory shell mobile

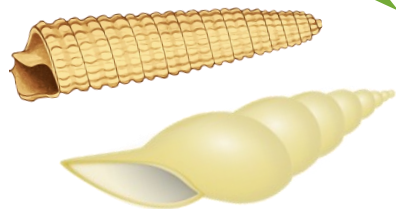
EYFS: Expressive arts and design: It is important that children have regular opportunities to engage with the arts, enabling them to explore and play with a wide range of media and materials.

### You are your child's teacher:

Use descriptive language: talk about what your child can feel, see and avoid asking questions.

Encourage your child to feel the texture of the shells.

Be warm, supportive, and encouraging.



Things you may need:

- Texture Card
- Shells
- Glue
- Scissors
- Stick
- String in various sizes
- Various pasta shapes
- Sticky pads



1. Choose a stick and tie strings to it-one string to hold the mobile up with and smaller strings to hang your shells on.
2. With adult supervision, cut shell shapes using different materials.
3. Stick different pasta shapes on to the shell shapes and let them dry.
4. Using the sticky pads join 2 shell shapes together with string in between so you can hang them on the mobile.
5. Hang the shells the same way so when there is a breeze you will hear a tinkling sound as they hit together.
6. Lastly, hang your mobile near a window and listen to the different sounds as the breeze moves your mobile around.
