

Name recognition activity

How to:

Write a child's name on a sheet of paper. Have the child use bingo dabbers to "trace" over the letters in their name, creating a fun, colourful effect.

This activity will help the child see the formation of letters that make up their name, and also helps develop fine motor skills strengthening hand muscles and improve hand-eye coordination.

If you don't have bingo dabbers, you could use felt tips or even cotton buds and paint.
