

Play Park Activity ideas

EYFS Physical development: Gross and fine motor experiences develop incrementally throughout early childhood, starting with sensory explorations and the development of a child's strength, co-ordination and positional awareness .

You are your child's teacher:

Use descriptive language: talk about what your child can see avoid asking questions.

Let your child explore the natural environment.

Be warm, supportive, and encouraging.



Outdoor learning:

Why not take your child to a woodland or natural environment. It helps your child to create a positive relationship with the natural environment. Collect different natural object to create magical bottle.

Collect twigs, flower or petal, grass and small stones.

You will need: all the above

A plastic bottle

Water



Painting on leaves: With your child go out and collect different size and shaped leaves, provide safe paint and brushes for your child to use. And let them be creative.

Roll in leaves: Dressed in appropriate clothing let your child roll around in the fallen leaves (ensure it is safe) giving them the opportunity to explore different textures, smells and colours.

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
