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## FOR INDICATIONS OF AUTISM AND/OR ADHD – GRADUATED RESPONSE

If you do not have any of the concerns mentioned above at step 1 you may wish to make a referral to the NPST for a review. Before doing so, please follow the graduated response process via your health visitor or the [SEND graduated response](#) through your child's education setting. Please note – referrals can only be accepted once the graduated response and support offer has been followed.

**Please note - a diagnosis is not required for reasonable adjustments to be put in place to support your child's needs within their education setting.**

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## REFERRALS TO NPST

Once step 2 above has been followed, a referral can then be made to the NPST by either your GP, Health Care Professional, Educational Senco Lead or alternatively a self-referral can be made.

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## AUTISM AND/OR ADHD SCREENING REVIEW

A screening review will be undertaken by the NPST for indicative behaviours of Autism and/or ADHD. Further interventions may also be recommended at this stage prior to step 4a.

### SCREENING REVIEW IDENTIFIED NEED FOR REVIEW WITH COMMUNITY PAEDIATRICS SERVICE

Your child's referral will be discussed with the Community Paediatrics Team.

If accepted your child will be placed on the Community Paediatric wait list for further review and closed to the NPST.

If not accepted, you/the referrer, will be informed of the outcome and sign posted as at step 6 below.

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### FURTHER SCREENING REVIEW OR INFORMATION REQUIRED

Your child's referral remains open for further review and information gathering.

This may include discussions with professionals such as CAMHS, speech & language therapy, Clinical Psychologists, along with observations in school/nursery and/or face-to-face reviews.

Where the review outcome indicates the need for further review with the Community Paediatrics Service, please see step 4a
